We have outlined three phases of which we will follow for the 2021-2022 school year. Our limited class sizes and large rooms will allow us to fully return with IN-classroom instruction with a few modifications.

We ask that you adhere to the following guidelines if your child is sick:

REPORT ABSENCE

You will be asked contact /symptom questions and will then receive an email with your child's projected return date.

NEW QUARANTINE POLICY

If in the last 24 hours has your child had someone in their household who is COVID+ and/or is your child experiencing ONE of the following symptoms/diagnosis:

- Tested **POSITIVE** for COVID-19
- Fever (100.4 or higher)
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Cough(not including seasonal allergies)
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Had someone in their household test **POSITIVE** for Covid-19

If the answer is **YES** to at least 1 of the above, your child **SHOULD NOT** come to school.

They should:

Self-quarantine for a **minimum of 5 days**. If by **DAY 5**, student isn't showing any of the above signs/symptoms, and/or has been tested and is COVID NEGATIVE they may return on **DAY 6**. (Parental option to 10 day quarantine, must be reported same as absence)

If student is showing any of the above signs/symptoms during the 5 day quarantine and/or tested COVID POSITIVE your child may not return until they are symptom free for 48 hours or **NO SOONER THAN DAY 11**.

If a classmate or teammate is COVID 19+ and student has had first hand exposure:

1 active case Students entire class/teacher will Self-quarantine for a **minimum of 5 days**. If by **DAY 5**, student isn't showing any of the above signs/symptoms, and/or has been tested and is COVID NEGATIVE they may return on **DAY 6**.

2+ active cases Students entire class will quarantine for **10 days**, returning on **DAY 11**.

Once form is submitted, you will receive an email /text within 1-2 hours. The email will confirm that the school has been notified of your child's absence, and provide you with a student's return date.

If a child and/or faculty member has a confirmed POSITIVE case of COVID-19 it must be reported to the school. **Failure to do so could result in immediate dismissal.**

If at any time Central School has over 34 percent students or faculty members with confirmed cases of COVID-19, FLU or any other infectious disease, closure will be determined at that time. Central School will coordinate phases with phases the state of Louisiana has determined at that time. (if the state is in Phase 1/CHS is in Phase 1 etc..)

We strive to provide students and faculty member with the safest possible environment, however, it takes us working together to be successful. These guide lines are subject to change as directed by State of Louisiana, Louisiana Department of Education and/or Mid-South Independent School Association.)

STATE OF LOUISIANA PHASE 1

PAYMENT

- GRADES K3 & K4- NO class/NO TUITION payment due
- GRADE K5- 12 - FULL RATE

TUITION INSTRUCTION

- GRADES K3 & K4- NO class/NO instruction
- GRADES K5-12- FULL IN class instruction (unless closure is mandated by state. At this time we will resume our full curriculum with virtual and/or paper packet, TBD by principal)
- If you feel that your student is at high risk, and would like to opt out of in class instruction, you may write a formal letter to principal with explanation for consideration of paper packet or online (KHAN) instruction. (method TBD by principal)

GROUP SIZE / VISITORS

- Classrooms limited to 10 students and/or faculty
- NO more than 10 people are allowed to congregate in common area
- NO visitors in lunch room or at school parties

FACE COVERINGS

- Students (3rd grade and up) and/or faculty highly recommended upon arrival (disposable mask are available if your student needs one). Once your student has passed temperature check they may remove face coverings and enter homeroom.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- All classroom desk 3 feet apart
- ALL students MUST bring lunch (lunch tables will be set up in classrooms/ and sanitized after every use.)
- Students must enter thru door labeled ENTER and exit thru door labeled EXIT

SANITATION

- Student/Faculty/Visitors temperature taken at arrival
- Water fountains closed for use
- Students and/or faculty may bring bottled water bottle (not reusable)
- Students and/or faculty must wash and/or sanitize their hands every 2 hours, or when entering a new building. (school will provide soap and/or hand sanitizer)
- Highly touched surfaces cleaned at a minimum of every 2 hours
- Lunch tables in room sanitized before and after lunch shifts
- Café staff will resume as custodial staff and intensify sanitation throughout the day
- Professional sanitation scheduled once a month

BUS

- will run at half capacity (with assigned seating; families seated together)
- Students will have temperature checked before riding bus
- hands sanitized before entering
- Bus will be sanitized twice a day
- High-touch places like doorknobs and seats will be sanitized before and after bus route

PAYMENT

- GRADES K3 & K4- FULL CLASS/FULLRATE TUITION
- GRADE K5- 12 – FULL CLASS/FULL RATE TUITION

INSTRUCTION

- GRADES K3-12TH
FULL IN class instruction

GROUP SIZE / VISITORS

- Classrooms limited to 15 students
- NO more than 25 people are allowed to congregate in common area
- 1 visitor per child in lunch room or at school parties (must sign in and have temperature checked at office)

FACE COVERINGS

- Students (3rd grade and up) and/or faculty highly recommended upon arrival (disposable mask are available if your student needs one). Once your student has passed temperature check they may remove face coverings and enter homeroom.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- All classroom desk placed 3 feet apart
- Café OPENED, 3 feet between each table and students assigned to every other seat.

- Students must enter thru door labeled ENTER and exit thru door labeled EXIT

SANITATION

- Student/Faculty/Visitors temperature taken at arrival
- Water fountains closed for use
- Students and/or faculty may bring bottled water bottle (not reusable)
- Students and/or faculty must wash and/or sanitize their hands every 2 hours, or when entering a new building. (school will provide soap and/or hand sanitizer)
- Highly touched surfaces cleaned at a minimum of every 2 hours
- Lunch tables in room sanitized before and after lunch shifts
- Café staff will resume as custodial staff and intensify sanitation throughout the day

- GRADES K3-12TH
FULL IN class instruction

GROUP SIZE / VISITORS

- Classrooms limited to 22 students
- NO more than 50 people are allowed to congregate in common area
- 1 visitor per child in lunch room or at school parties (must sign in and have temperature checked at office)

FACE COVERINGS

- Students (3rd grade and up) and/or faculty highly recommended upon arrival (disposable mask are available if your student needs one). Once your student has passed temperature check they may remove face coverings and enter homeroom.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- All classroom desk placed 3 feet apart

- Café OPENED, 3 feet between each table and students assigned to every other seat
- Students must enter thru door labeled ENTER and exit thru door labeled EXIT

SANITATION

- Student/Faculty/Visitors temperature taken at arrival
- Water fountains OPEN for use
- Students and/or faculty may bring bottled water bottle (not reusable)
- Students and/or faculty must wash and/or sanitize their hands every 2 hours, or when entering a new building. (school will provide soap and/or hand sanitizer)
- Highly touched surfaces cleaned at a minimum of every 2 hours
- Lunch tables in room sanitized before and after lunch shifts
- Café staff will resume as custodial staff and intensify sanitation throughout the day
- Professional sanitation scheduled once a month

BUS

- Run at full capacity (with assigned seating; families seated together)
- Students and/or faculty will have temperature checked before riding bus
